



Screencast

- Created by teacher to explain problems, content, or process. Can be used for reteaching or flipped classroom.
- Students can record process of solving problem as assessment or for other students.



-Showme- Record on interactive whiteboard with images & text.



-Educreations-record on interactive whiteboard with images & text.



-Groupboard-(similar to two above) collaborative interactive whiteboard, draw & chat in real time with others even on web, up to 5 users on same board with free version. Sign up online, users must have password to collaborate. Tap with three fingers to get toolbar. Available on Android

Annotations

- iAnnotate PDF (Android)



-pdf-notes-Open pdf from Google or Dropbox, export to Google, Dropbox or email. Highlight, draw, or add notes to document.

Stories

Little Bird Tales (web) & Story Jumper (web)



-StoryKit-create story with sounds, images, text, & illustrations.



-Kabaam-(\$.99)-import up to 9 photos, add speech bubbles to create a comic.

Mind Maps

- gather thoughts, collaborate, compare two pics/maps/characters, take notes.
- screen shot to export, send to photos or via email.



-Mindomo-create mindmaps by adding pictures, emoticons, task info, notes, and export as image or PDF. Includes themes & possibility of turning into a presentation. *Available on all platforms and web*



-Inspiration Maps Lite-many templates for different purposes, turn mind map into outline, change shapes and add images. Very easy to use & maneuver. Export with screenshot or as inspiration file.



-SimpleMind+-create simple mind maps. Color-coded, easy use, no frills, export via email. *Available on Android*

Presentation

- Slide Rocket (web), Google Drive (web & Android), Slidepunch Slideshow Creator (Android)



-Sonic Pics (\$2.99)-add photos and narration to create a slideshow. Publish to YouTube, export or email.



-Nearpod- Enables teachers to use their iPads to manage content on students' iPads, iPhones or iPods. Combines presentation, collaboration, and real-time assessment tools into one solution.

Available on Android.

Photos

- Write notes, highlight, or label a digital document or picture as assessment or with instruction.
- *PicsArt-Photo Studio (Android)*



-Pic Collage-add photos and use backgrounds + stickers to make a collage. Edit or crop photos and add text over top. Email or screen shot when finished. *Available on Android*



-Fotobabble-add narration to photos to creating talking photos, create a story about your image. Export via email or screen shot.



-Sketch-Add shapes, text, and sketch over images + share. Amazing! Draw and create on pictures, web pages, and screen shots! Export via email or screen shot. *Available on Android*



-Photo Mess-Add photos into one collage, add text, and templates available.

Podcast

- Record book reviews, interviews, debates for further discussion, record audio to use in multimedia presentation, record reading for fluency, record lectures or overview of lesson to share with students.
- Audacity (web)



-iTalk Recorder-Easy recording, able to share via iTunes or email. Three levels of quality. For longer podcasts to be shared via email, choose good or better quality.



-SoundCloud-Record and upload to account on web. Free app allows for 120 minutes of recording to be posted on web. No fancy features but must have account. *Available on Android*



-Voice Pad-Record audio and take notes or draw simultaneously. Can use notes as script for recording audio. Tag audio with notes. Email recording to share.



-Evernote-Note-taking app that can include images, audio files and more. Shared on all digital platforms. Can record audio using notes or using notes as script. *Available on all platforms & web*

Video

- *Video Slideshow Maker (Android)*



-Animoto-Add photos, videos, and audio to create video slideshow. Free version is limited to 30 seconds and allows 12 slides (each video, picture and text is a slide). Share via email or add to camera roll. Teachers can apply for free education version to add student accounts (age 13 and older). *Available on Android*



-Sock Puppets-create lip-synched videos by adding props, scenery, and backgrounds. Record audio and puppets lip-synch to your voice. Free version is limited to 30 seconds.

Cartoons



-Toontastic-create scene for each step of story arc: setup, conflict, challenge, climax and resolution. Draw or choose background, choose characters and record actions & audio. Share on ToonTube.



-Puppet Pals-choose actors & backdrops, drag on to stage, and record. Movements & audio are recorded. Export to camera roll then share via email. YouTube or computer.



-PhotoComic (\$.99)-Select layout and add photos to create a comic. Add speech bubbles & action words. Interaction with all objects is possible. Export via email.
